



# **2011 MENS NIGHT**

The 2011 season will have 24 weeks of Sponsored Men's Night play!

**Time:** Tuesdays after 1pm.

18-hole entry deadline: no deadline as the 18 hole competition will be finalized the following day!

9-hole entry deadline: 5:00pm every week, no exceptions!

**Eligible Players:** Open to all males, 19 years and older

**Entry Fees (mandatory 9-hole game):** \$10

- \$4 scoring prizes (net & gross) gift certificates
- \$1 flighted skill prizes (\$.50 per prize) KP & Long Putt in all flights (only Long Putt in callaway flight), gift certificates
- \$4 flighted skins game (cash)
- \$1 to men's club for general revenue

**Entry Fees (optional 18-hole game):** \$5

- Gift certificate prizing
- All 18-hole scoring will be completed the following day
- **Note NEW procedure for 2011**
  - When 18-hole entries are **fourteen (14) players or less in a flight**, Low Gross and Low Net prizes will be awarded (**2 GC's**)
  - When 18-hole entries are **fifteen (15) players or more in a flight**, 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Gross and 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Net will be awarded (**4 GC's**). Split will be based approximately on 70% for 1<sup>st</sup> place and 30% for 2<sup>nd</sup>.

- **NO 18-HOLE GAME IN THE CALLAWAY FLIGHT!**

**Flight Breakdown (adjusted on July 5/11):**

- #1 (0-10 Handicap)
- #2 (11-14 Handicap)
- #3 (15 and up Handicap)
- #4 (Callaway-No Handicap)

**Prize Purse:** \$325 from nightly sponsor + \$4 per player of the \$10 entry fee

- Flights #1, #2 and #3 are subsidized \$50 each by the weekly sponsor
- Flight #4 (callaway) is not subsidized if less than 10 players
- Flight #4 (callaway) is subsidized \$25 if 10 players or more
- The remaining sponsorship money (\$150 or \$175) is used for draw prizes
- Utilize gift certificate payout grid to determine amounts and quantity of gift certificates.  
(Reminder: use correct sponsor subsidy page)

**Green Fees:** 18 hole - \$39 (tax in), 9 hole - \$28 (tax in).

**Competition:** Players will use 50% of their handicap for the 9-hole competition, 100% of their attested handicap for the 18-hole competition. If no handicap card, golfer is placed in the Callaway flight! No exceptions, please!

**Tie Break:** If there is a tie, we will use the RCGA method of retrogression; best last 9 for the 18 hole game, best last 6, best last 3, best hole by hole (better score is the winner). For the 9-hole game, start at best last 6, etc.

**Skill Prizes: 9 Holes** - \$.50 per player, per prize, included with entry fee (GC's)

#2 (11-14 HCP)	Hole #4	Hole #3

**Draw Prize Format:** All players who purchase 50/50 tickets are eligible for draw prizes. Draw prizes will be awarded in conjunction with the sale of 50/50 tickets for the 2011 season. Players must be in attendance at prize presentation (or still on the golf course) to be eligible to win a draw prize. Men's Night organizers will combine smaller items in an attempt to keep all prizing of similar value. End of evening is the 50/50 draw for cash money!
