LOCAL RULES:

1. Out of Bounds - Defined by boundary fences and white stakes. A ball which crosses a public road (Shannon Lake Road) defined as out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is out of bounds, even though it may lie on another part of the course. (Decision 27-20) The parking lot and clubhouse area are out of bounds as defined by white stakes and the boundary fence behind the #5 green.
2. Obstructions - All staked trees, flower beds, yardage markers, and irrigation fixtures are considered immovable obstructions. (Rule 24-2) 150 yard markers may be considered movable obstructions at the player's discretion. Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions. (Rule 24-1)
3. Water Hazards - The area left of Hole #4 & #5 is considered a lateral hazard. The margin of the hazard is defined by red stakes and/or a red painted line. The pond beside the 12th green is considered a lateral hazard. The margin of the hazard is the outside edge of the paving stones surrounding the hazard. The paving stones are considered an integral part of the course. Cart path on Hole #17 to the right of the green is within the margin of the hazard, therefore no free relief is given.
4. Starters / Course Marshals - Will monitor pace of play and general conduct. They have absolute authority, please respect their decisions. **Patrons waive all liability claims.**
