Competition and Flight Breakdown

Men in flight 1&2 will be playing from the **Blue/white** tees on Saturday & **Blue** tees on Sunday. Men in flight 3&4 will be playing from the **Blue/white** tees both days. The women will be playing from the **Red** tees on Saturday and **Red/White** tees on Sunday. SLGC Member handicaps were drawn from the Golf Canada Handicap system on **Thursday, September 21st, 2023 at 2:00pm.** Flights have been determined using an "average" handicap of the two courses being played with the goal of having a similar number of players in each flight. The competition is individual stroke gross play and individual stroke net play. **59 of the 62 men are entered into the optional daily flighted, gross skins game. (Cash - \$10 per day)**
