



## **MEN'S DAY - 2022**

**TUESDAYS | ALL DAY LONG | ENTRY FEE - \$15**

The 2022 season will have 21 competitions over 24 weeks of scheduled play. Competition will start on **Tuesday, April 19** and end on **Tuesday, September 27**. There will be no competitions on the days we aerate the greens and during the BC Juvenile Championship.

**Competition: Front 9 only - Blue/White Tees.** Players will use **50% of their handicap** for the competition. If a player does not have a Golf Canada handicap, he will be assigned a 0, a 9 or a 16 handicap based on "BEST SCORE EVER".

### **Flight Breakdown:**

- #1 (0-8 Handicap)
- #2 (9-15 Handicap)
- #3 (16 and up Handicap)

**Eligible Players: ALL Male golfers, 19 years and older!**

**Entry Fee: \$15**

### **Gift Certificate COMPETITION Portion: \$5**

- \$5 to scoring prizes (gross & net), paid out in gift certificates
- **We have adjusted the "gift certificate payout grid" based on a prize purse of \$5 per player. This grid is used to determine the amounts and quantity of gift certificates to be issued within each of the four flights**
- 1 low gross prize per flight, the rest will all be net prizes

### **Cash SKINS Game: \$5**

- **Flighted** skins game (gross), paid out in cash
- Make the low score on any hole within your flight and share in the pot

### Cash DOUBLE DEUCE pot: \$0

- **Flighted** double duce pot, paid out in cash
- Make two 2's on the front 9 and win the cash
- Pot funds will not be "fed" going forward. When the pot is won in any flight the game will be discontinued
- If you've played less than 3 times, you will only be able to win 50% of the winning "share"
- **Cash Pots to start 2022: Flight #1 - \$0 | Flight #2 - \$259 | Flight #3 - \$779**

### 50/50 Draw: \$5

- All winnings paid out daily
- Two prizes awarded, 50% cash and 50% is a golf shop merchandise prize
- Winners will be posted on-line

### Golf Fees (Member/Guest rates will be offered):

**After 2:00 PM: 18 holes walking - \$48 + tax      Riding - \$65 + tax**  
**After 4:00 PM: 9 holes walking - \$33 + tax      Riding - \$44 + tax**

**Tie Break:** For our 9-hole scoring competition, we will use the Golf Canada method of retrogression. We will first look at who had the better last 6 holes, then best last 3, then hole by hole (with the better score being the winner).

**Mak Transportation Points Race:** Continuing for 2022, we'll be running a season long points race for all participants in Men's Day. Points will be awarded as follows; 25 for participating, then bonus points for finishing in the "top 5" in your flight. 1<sup>st</sup> Gross – 70 pts, 1<sup>st</sup> Net – 60 pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> Net – 50 pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> Net – 40 pts, 4<sup>th</sup> Net – 30 pts.
